

AWA National Water Week Poster Competition *proudly supported by* **nylex** Terms and Conditions

- 1. Entry to the AWA National Water Week Poster Competition 2021 is free.
- 2. Entries open on 11 October 2021 and close on 11 November 2021.
- 3. Entry is open to all primary school aged children in Australia, from first year of school through to Year 6. Multiple entries can be submitted on one form per category. For registered home school students, one entry in the relevant category can be made by a parent or guardian.
- 4. The five categories include first year of school, grade 1-2, grade 3-4 and grade 5-6 as well as a special needs category.
- 5. Entries close at midnight AEDT, Thursday 11 November 2021.
- 6. Prizes will be awarded to the winning student and school through the school contact. No contact with the students will be made by AWA, Nylex or the judges. To submit a poster into the competition the school contact must have parent/guardian permission in writing.
- 7. Posters must be A3 or A4 size and submitted digitally by a representative of the school (i.e. a teacher), or home schooling parent/guardian, by attaching the electronic file using the form on the AWA National Water Week website https://www.awa.asn.au/nationalwaterweek
- 8. Entries are to be the work of individual students, collaborative poster artwork will not be accepted
- 9. The National Water Week Committee chaired by AWA will judge the posters based on the criteria published on AWA's website and select winners in each category. The judges' decisions are final.
- 10. Immediate family members of employees of Australian Water Association (AWA), the competition sponsor Nylex or judges of the competition are not permitted to enter.
- 11. Winners will be notified by email on 19 November 2021 via the school contact using details provided with the entry.

- 12. The winning student in each category will be awarded a Nylex prize pack to the value of \$150, including a Nylex electronic tap timer, flextreme, tube oscillating sprinkler and two litre watering can.
- 13. The winning student's school will receive a Nylex prize pack to the value of \$350, including a digital weather station, a Nylex 20 metre retractable hose reel and a premium 7-function spray gun.
- 14. Prizes are not transferable.
- 15. If the school communicates information about the competition or winners, official National Water Week 2021 branding must be included and the competition should be referred to in full as follows: 'AWA National Water Week Poster Competition proudly supported by Nylex'.
- 16. AWA is happy to work with winning schools and the local water utility to seek local media coverage for the winners if desired by the student and the school.
- 17. Winning posters along with the students' first name and last initial, age and school name will be published on AWA's website and across AWA communications channels such as by email and social posts on LinkedIn, Facebook and Instagram.
- 18. By submitting an entry into AWA National Water Week Poster Competition 2021, entrants will assign limited copyright of the image to the competition organisers enabling reproduction of the image for public displays and publications (both print and digital) in conjunction with the competition AND for the purpose of publication in printed and digital material promoting water, including National Water Week in subsequent years. Students will be credited whenever the posters are used.
- 19. AWA will protect information provided in accordance with the Information Privacy Act 2000. Information contained in your entry form/s may be stored and used by AWA for the purpose of managing National Water Week. Entries will not be accepted without contact information provided with the entry. This information may be disclosed to relevant government agencies or other stakeholders if required by law in accordance with the Information Privacy Act 2000 only.
